It is bring to your kind notice that Government of Telangana has approved the guidelines to be followed for final allocation of employees in power sector in the state of Telangana which are not in accordance with Section 82 of A.P.Reorganization Act 2014. Further in the order of Telangana Government nativity (place of birth of the employees as per service register) is taken as the criteria for division which is against the provisions of A.P.Reorganization Act, 2014

It is requested to stop division of employees on the basis of unilateral guidelines issued by Government of Telangana, which are against the spirits of A.P.Reorganization Act, 2014. Abrupt allocation of posts and personnel belonging to power utilities of these two states and without just and equitable guidelines consented by both the states will create serious repercussions and Law & Order problems.

Meeting held on 20.03.2015 in the presence of Sri Anantha Kumar Singh, Addl.Secy, Ministry of Home Affairs , Government of India in presence of Chief Secretaries of both the states , it has been agreed with regard to that mutually accepted principals for staff division can be adopted. Further the Secretary to Government , Energy Department , Government of Andhra Pradesh raised the issues of division of employees among power sector utilities of A.P. and Telangana, it was agreed that division of employees done as per A.P.Reorganization Act 2014 by a Joint Committee of power utilities of both the states.
