This has reference to the meeting held in the presence of Additional Secretary (Home), Govt. of India wherein the Secretaries (Energy) of both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana States were present. The discussion of bifurcation of employees came up during the meeting and it was agreed to form a Joint Committee with representatives from power utilities of both the States which will finalize bifurcation of employees within the framework of Andhra Pradesh State Reorganization Act, 2014.

It is noticed that a common Committee is constituted by the Telangana Power Utilities, which has recommended that the nativity recorded in the Service Register of the individual in respect of initial cadre/appointment shall be taken as basis for determining the native district of the employee. The lists prepared accordingly are placed in the website of TS TRANSCO.

As per Section 82 of AP Reorganization Act 2014 and also as per the discussions referred above, it is requested to instruct the concerned authorities of Telangana Power Utilities not to proceed unilaterally and to form a Joint Committee with Andhra Pradesh Power Utilities to finalize the bifurcation of employees in power sector within the framework of the Act.
